## SAFETY FIRST

---

Our first priority is to provide a safe place where kids of all ages can play hockey. In order to do this, we need cooperation from everyone. Here are a few reminders:

All equipment must be worn properly, that goes for team officials as well- please remember to do up your chin straps!

In order to prevent cuts, once skates are on, please remain seated until the coach says it's time to leave the room.

Speak-Out teaches a 2 deep policy- meaning if you're an adult in a change room, there should be a second adult there as well, if not, please leave the change room.

Buckets & Gloves is a very dangerous 'tradition' in some hockey associations. CYO has a zero tolerance for fighting, of any kind, on the ice or off and will indefinitely suspend all players and team officials participating or allowing the practice to continue.
